The above listed are the **ONLY** persons who may legitimately use the title Architect and carry out the work of an Architect in Zimbabwe, for gain or practice or carry on business under any name, style or title which contain the word "Architect".

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is The Architects Council of Zimbabwe? The ACZ is a statutory body that exists to uphold the conditions of The Architects Act; and to provide for the REGISTRATION and REGULATION of the practice of Architects in Zimbabwe.

What is The Architects Act? The Architects Act of Zimbabwe (1975) is an Act of Parliament that provides for the REGISTRATION & REGULATION of the practice of Architects in Zimbabwe.

How does The Architects Act protect the public by Registering Architects?

- In return for an accepted minimum standard of conduct and professional performance, both the title and the work of an Architect is protected, and can only be carried out by those who have satisfied the minimum requirements to be permitted to be entered in the Register as an Architect.
- A REGISTERED Architect is a professional who has a current registration with the regulatory body - The Architects Council of Zimbabwe. If an individual is without either credential then they may be operating unregulated, providing you with no guarantees of their ability to deliver the service you require.
- It is an offence for anyone who is not a REGISTERED Architect to pose as an Architect; or carry out the work of an Architect.

In the Act, what is defined as the work of an Architect?

- The Third Schedule of The Architects Act sets out works as either being EXEMPTED or NON-EXEMPTED works.

- NON-EXEMPTED WORKS refers to any work that requires the involvement of a Registered Architect.
- EXEMPTED WORKS refers to any work that does not necessarily require the involvement of a Registered Architect.
- Note that the work of an Architect covers all nature of building works and is not restricted to Non-Exempted Works - Public, Residential, Educational, Institutional, Commercial, Industrial and Healthcare projects of any size and complexity. - It is an offence for anyone who is not a REGISTERED Architect to carry out NON-EXEMPTED works - defined in The Architects Act.

Further Points to note:

- The title Architect is a protected title and only a REGISTERED Architect may use this title. Under the terms of The Architects Act (1975) so that only those who have undergone rigorous training, and are fully qualified and REGISTERED, can rightly use it in any context - professional or social.
- It is an offence for any REGISTERED Architect to submit works on behalf of an unregistered or unqualified person.

Temporary Registration for Foreign Architects

- Under the Architects Act, any foreign Architects who wish to undertake an architectural commission in Zimbabwe are required to take out temporary registration with the Architects Council of Zimbabwe. Please contact ACZ for further guidance.
